
America Wall Hanging by Desert Bird Or Small Lap Quilt. Finished dimensions: 46.5" x 46.5"




Sample uses "Slate Garden" as the blender.

This beginner level quilt will work well with any other Desert Bird panel set that is formatted as a large illustration and six small illustrations. The main assembly is 46.5" x 46.5" and can be made larger with additional sashing around the outside.

Materials: 1 Desert Bird panel set that includes 1 22" x 27" and 6 9"x9" panels. This includes the following panel sets: "America", "Cactus Scenes", "Acequia Parade", "The City Different", "NM Road Trip", and "Farm Life".

In addition, you will need 1 1/4 yard of a fabric that coordinates with your panel set.

Cut Instructions: In our example, you are cutting spacing panels and strips from a single blender. The image on the left shows the general layout and on the right is how you will cut.



Assembly Instructions:

Assembly 1: Create a row of 3 smaller illustrations separated by 2 9"x9" blender squares. Add a 2.5"x 43" strip to the top and bottom. Press and trim for straight edges. Add a 2.5" x 14" strip to the left and right sides. Press and trim for straight edges.

Assembly 2: Repeat instructions for assembly 1.

Assembly 3: Add a 11x22" panel to the left and right sides of the 22"x27" panel. Press and trim for straight edges.

Final Assembly: Stitch assembly 1 to the top of assembly 3. Stitch assembly 2 to the bottom of assembly 3. Press and trim
